### ATIU

Atiu, traditionally known as Enua Manu (the land of birds), is one of the three close islands of the Southern Group known as 'Nga-Pu-Toru' - grouped with Mitiaro and Mauke. Atiu is the third largest island in the Cook Islands. Its spectacular ecosystem homes fringed coastlines with coral cliffs, hidden beach coves and caves, as well as dense tropical rainforests. Atiu is a Wildlife Sanctuary for many endemic and threatened bird species, many of which are found on the uninhabited Island of Takutea - 20 Kilometres north-west of Atiu. It is also an island with a fascinating history, culture, and traditions.

### ATIU ACCOMMODATION & TOURS

Atiu Villas is located on the peaceful outskirts of the main village, Areora. It is a small and intimate property with six villas - five of which are Self-Contained Units, and a Family Unit. Each one was constructed almost entirely out of locally sourced materials including mahogany, mango and coconut trees. The villas are strategically placed to blend seamlessly into their tropical surroundings and to allow for privacy from other villas.

The accommodation is a 15 minute drive from the airport, 3 minutes to the small township and 400 metres from Areora Café, which offers a small breakfast, lunch and dinner menu, and great coffee.

Your **Island Eco Tour** begins as soon as you are picked up from your accommodation by the birdman—George Mateariki, a man with a vast wealth of knowledge of the Atiuan ecosystem.

This tour gives you a great foundation at the beginning of your stay. Discover hidden tracks & spectacular white sand beaches. Dramatic variations in bush and coastal scenery. Rich sea & bird life. Learn of the people of Enuamanu, their history, customs and the conservation programmes.

**Kia Orana Bungalows** is an intimate property of six stand-alone bungalows located just off the main road in the village of Areora, and offers peace and relaxation to those who stay with them.

The Bungalows are simple, comfortable and clean. Interiors are of studio layout with basic amenities such as tea & coffee making facilities, a refrigerator, pedestal fan, bathroom with toilet and hot shower, balcony with furniture and relaxing views across to the tropical forest.

Your **Anatakitaki Cave Tour** begins with a 30-minute trek through the rainforest and over rugged terrain of makatea (raised coral limestone). Along the way, your tour guide will take time to explain the various plants, trees and their many uses. You will also learn about the coral limestone formations and see fossilised shells embedded in them, some of which date back 120,000 years.

Suitable for those with reasonable fitness and agility, involves some climbing, walking over uneven and rugged terrain. Not suitable for those who cannot walk long distances, elderly persons, or those with walking difficulties and bad knees.

### MANGAIA

Mangaia, traditionally known as Au'au Enua, lies 203 kilometres Southeast of Rarotonga, and is predicted to be 18 million years old - a significant finding to geologist. The island is specially known for its surrounding band of makatea (raised coral cliffs), as well as its sunken interior plateau, lush wetlands, hidden caves, golden shells, and stone carvings. This Close-Encounters packages to Mangaia is a natural wonderland of discovery and adventure. Experience this untainted island of the Southern Group, its unique natural beauty and the authenticity to its history, culture and people.

#### MANGAIA ACCOMMODATION & TOURS

**Babes Place** is located in Oneroa Village, a small budget well kept property with four basic units, and two double rooms in the main house, where the communal kitchen, shared lounge and laundry facilities are located.

Each of the four Units are equipped with a double and single bed, pedestal or wall fan, and a private bathroom with toilet and shower. The two bedrooms in the main house are spacious, each with a double bed and additional double or single bed, large open windows, a dresser and fan. These rooms share a toilet and shower.

A few feet from the doorstep of the units is a large communal hut with tables and chairs where guests can relax, mix and mingle with other guests.

Babes Place is conveniently located only a few minutes walk to the main town where you will find the market place, grocery stores, and the local bank.

**The Island Tour** is a great way to explore this ancient natural wonderland, and discover its unique interior and costal landscapes. Your tour guides will share with you the fascinating history, and many myths and legends that have long been passed down from generation to generation.

This tour takes you from the main Village of Oneroa, through to the only other two villages on the island - Ivirua and Tamarua. Meet locals along the way and learn their way of life. See plantations, hidden beaches, rugged coral cliffs, and enjoy learning the process of the arts and crafts unique to Mangaia.

**Golden Shells Tour** is a unique experience offered only by the people of Mangaia. 'Golden Shells', which are also known as Pupu, are well-known throughout the Cook Islands and a great addition to any wardrobe. This tour showcases the delicate process of collecting the shells (pupu), to the creation of the beautiful ei pupu.

You will be left with a deep appreciation and understanding of why the people of Mangaia choose to show their love by gifting Ei Pupu.

## MITIARO

Mitiaro, traditionally known as Nukuroa, is one of the three islands of the 'Nga-Pu-Toru' - with Mauke, approx. 45 kilometres northwest and Atiu, approx. 82.3 kilometres south-east of Mauke. Like Mangaia, it is encircled by a band of makatea (raised coral cliffs) with a fertile interior. Mitiaro is renowned for its fresh water twin lakes in the centre of the island, and home to the Itiki eel - a local delicacy. Home to limestone caves with fresh water pools and the Pritchardia Mitiaroana - a variety of Fan Palm native to Mitiaro, and the beautifully woven baskets the local women craft from the leaves of Pandanus trees.

### MITIARO ACCOMMODATION & TOURS

**Divine Retreat** is a large modern holiday home located in the main village, approximately 5 mintues from the airport. Divine Retreat is ownded by Junior and Cindy Abraham - your hospitable hosts who live on-site and will ensure your stay with them is most memorable.

Accommodation options at the retreat include Two Guest Bedrooms inside the house which share a bathroom. The Honeymoon Suite is accessible from the veranda and has its own private bathroom. Separate to the house are two individual One Bedroom Villas.

Facilities at Divine Retreat include a fully eqipped modern kitchen, self laundry facilities, a spacious veranda with a large dining table, and outdoor lounge suites for guests to relax and mix and mingle.

The **Island Tour** takes you to a number of fascinating sites around the island including the twin lakes Te Rotonui & Te Rotoiti, home to the local delicacy Itiki (eel) and the Silapia (milk fish), which was introduced in the early 1970s by the Ministry of Agriculture. Between these two lakes, they make up a large part of Mitiaro.

Mitiaro is also known for its fresh water limestone caves, Vai Nauri being one of the popular swimming caves for the locals and visitors alike. Vai Marere is a Sulphuric water cave, said to have healing properties and known to cure a number of disease. Both these caves are easily accesible with steps and railings to assist one with getting down to the water. Vai Tamaroa is a 20 minute trek over sharp makatea (coral), and sturdy footwear is definitely required for this trek. This walk is not recommended for those with walking issues.

The Island Tour also takes you to the Community Hall where your tour guide will explain the history of the island. Here you will also have the opportunity to purchase some locally-made arts & crafts unique to Mitiaro - crafted by the local mamas, they include woven baskets made from pandanus leaves, and one of a kind hand sewn bedspreads known as Tivaevae.

Mitiaro has so much to offer, and we cannot wait for you to experience the serene and tranquil beauty this small piece of paradise has to offer.

#### MAUKE ACCOMMODATION & TOURS

**Ri's Retreat** is located just under 2 minutes from the airport, and is a short walk to Uriaata Beach. Set amongst lush tropical gardens and green lawns are three simple self-contained studios, each with a double and single bed, shower & toilet, and a small kitchen with refrigerator/ freezer, kettle and an oven with cooktop.

There is also a two-bedroom self-contained house with the same facilities that sleep up to six guests. Meals are served at the dining and communal hut which is a great place to meet other inhouse guests. Guests are otherwise welcome to take their meals back to their rooms to enjoy.

**Tiare Cottages** is located on the west coast has four units (Okiva, Tipani and Tiare). Surrounded by lush gardens and tropical fauna each unit contains its own bathroom and kitchenette. Share meals and engage in conversations in the communal kitchen that forms the hub of Tiare Cottages.

The seafront unit Okiva rests on fossilized coral (makatea) with its own remote beach cove. Rest and dwell in a peaceful holiday in tranquility on the island of Mauke.

The Island Tour with your local tour guide, takes you on a fascinating adventure to explore Mauke's many hidden secrets. From the island's lush interiors and their hidden fresh water caves, to the ruggest coasts. You will visit many places of interest, including sites of historical significance. Throughout the tour you will not only discover what makes Mauke unique to its sister islands, but also what connects them. You will appreciate the stories and history shared, the culture and traditions still practised today, and most importantly the slow paced island life the locals sustainably live, enjoy and value.
